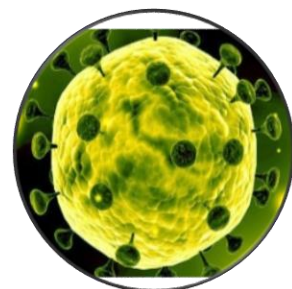

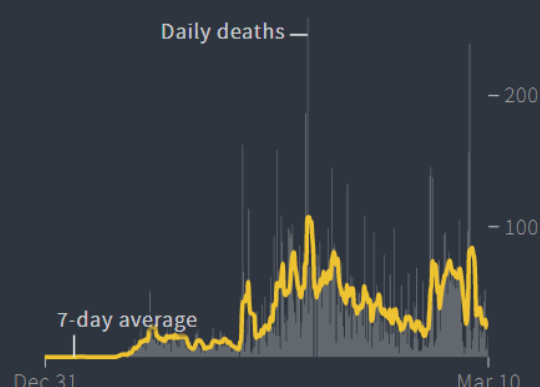
There have been **603,308** infections and **12,545** coronavirus-related deaths reported in the country since the pandemic began.

Deaths



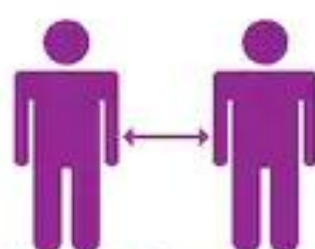
