

## Guidelines for All Students Participating in Limited Face-to-Face Classes

1. Limited face-to-face classes will only be conducted in Weeks 2, 4, 6, and 9, from Mondays to Thursdays only. All other classes will be implemented in fully online mode.

2. Students participating in limited face-to-face classes must have submitted to the Registrar's Office proof of vaccination status and proof of registration with PhilHealth or medical insurance covering Covid-19. These documents can be emailed to [registrar@mapua.edu.ph](mailto:registrar@mapua.edu.ph) on or before February 24, 2022 at 12 noon.

Only those who submitted these documents will be allowed entry to limited face-to-face classes next week.

Those who are not registered in PhilHealth or do not have existing medical insurance covering Covid-19 may consider Malayan's Vital Cover. To find out more about the cover, click the applicable link below:

3. Other students can join the limited face-to-face classes later by submitting documents either before week 4, week 6, or week 9.
4. All students who will attend their classes on campus can go directly to their assigned laboratory rooms.
5. During breaktime, students may use the 3/F Student Study Area, Canteen, and G/F Student "Tambayan." Students are advised to bring their own food inside the campus, as the Canteen stores will remain closed until further notice.
6. Students participating in limited face-to-face classes can also use the main library. The library shall strictly implement reservation-based access to the library spaces and resources.
